How to apply to the IUT when you are an Erasmus Exchange Student

This is what you need to do next:

1- Apply online:

Title your e-mail DOSSIER MOVEON ENTRANTS 2018-2019

2-Fill in your Erasmus Learning Agreement, please sign it and have it signed by your home institution and please send it to marie.tredy@univ-amu.fr

3-Two weeks later, we will issue a **letter of admission** and we will send it to your home institution and to you by e-mail. If you need a paper copy, please specify.

4-Reserve your accommodation: Please have a look at the student residence websites and let us know if you do not wish to stay there, as a room has been pre-reserved for you. If you wish to stay there, you will then receive an e-mail asking you to log on to Interlog (our student accommodation platform) and you will be asked to either accept or reject the room offer in the student residence that is being sent to you. Check your spams!

5-When you arrive in September at the IUT, you will need to go to the admissions office called “La Scolarité” to **finalise your admission**.

You will need to bring the following documents:

- The application file. You will be able to download it later on from our website under “Inscription”
- Copy of your valid passport
- European health card
- A passport photo to issue your student card
